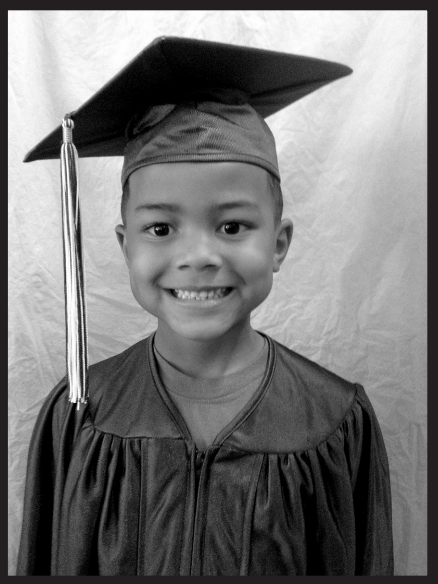
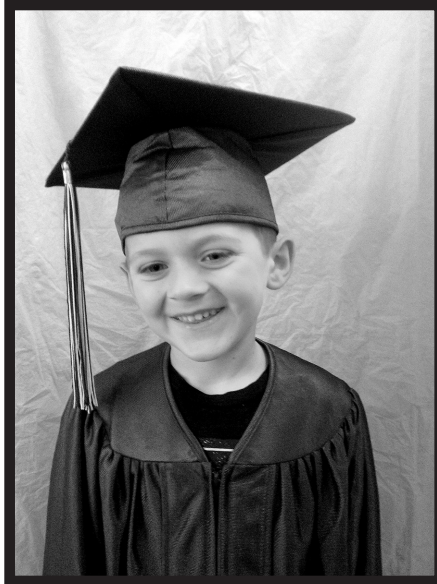

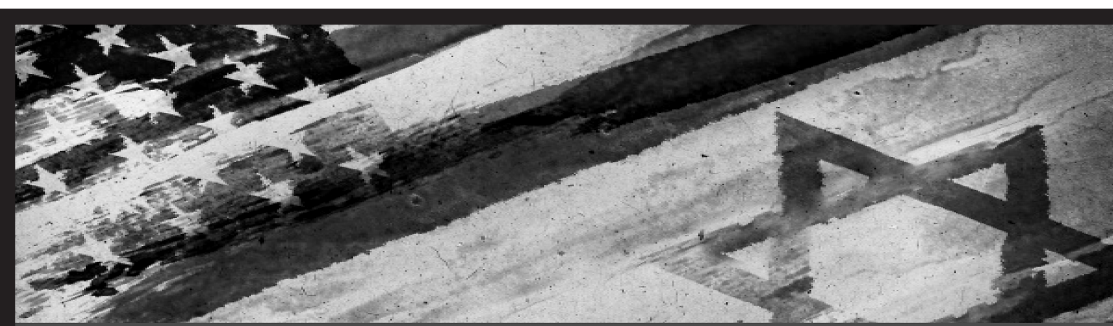

The 9th of Av is the major day of communal mourning in the Jewish calendar. Join BZ as we commemorate on Saturday evening, August 10th.

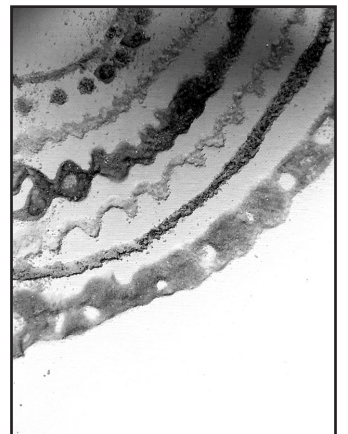


The 15th of Av is the Jewish Day of Love, similar to Valentine's Day. Join us as we celebrate with a special Shabbat on August 17th.
